

Walbridge Aldinger Co. wins \$14.2 million U.S. Army contract

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Detroit-based **Walbridge Aldinger Co.** has won a \$14.2 million contract to repair and renovate the Maneuver Center of Excellence building in Fort Benning, Ga., by next fall.

The construction management and engineering firm was the winner among three bidders before the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Savannah District, for the firm-fixed price contract. Work is set for completion in October 2011.

Renovation will begin next month and will update an office building with classroom and meeting space on the fort grounds, said Walbridge media relations manager Mark Marymee.

Primary work includes repairs to an 88,000-square-foot building, including exterior masonry, roofing, plumbing, electrical and other systems to meet anti-terrorism and force protection requirements. Other improvements include exterior utilities and a parking lot at the site.

Last month, a joint venture of Walbridge and Alabama-based **Brasfield & Gorrie LLC** won a \$40.6 million fixed price contract from the **U.S. Naval Facilities Engineering Command** in Washington to build a new Navy Exchange building in Bethesda, Md. Walbridge was also set this year to complete a \$14.2 million design and construction project at White Sands Missile Range in New Mexico.
